### LOT 367

A mid-19th century Russian silver snuff box, 84 zolotnik, of rectangular form with curved ends, engraved with foliate scrolls, Moscow 1869, weight 56.5g, length 7cm, an Edwardian silver envelope card case with engraved decoration, Birmingham 1905 by Adie & Lovekin Ltd, length 7.9cm, and a silver slide-action engine turned twin-section stamp case, Birmingham 1905, length 5.3cm, weight 50.4g, together with a silver mounted book of Common Prayer and a matching Hymns book, height 5.5cm.

### Condition Report

367. Russian box - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to engraving, but still fairly crisp decoration. Hinge is good and closes tightly. Small dent to base. Marks readable.

Envelope card case - good condition. Hinge is good. Slight rubbing to decoration, particularly to back. Good clear hallmarks. Engraved initials to front.

Stamp case - few dents to front and back. Typical wear to decoration. Marks readable but a little worn.

Two silver mounted books - typical minor dents and wear. Marks slightly rubbed. Leather backs with scuffs, but otherwise good.
