LOT 510

A gold backed, diamond, ruby, demantoid garnet and pearl brooch, designed as a wreath with trefoil shaped motifs at intervals, unmarked, weight 4.8g, width 2.6cm (pearls untested), with an associated Asprey case.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

One pearl reglued into position.

Brooch has sustained damaged, it used to be spherical but is now misshaped.

Pin in working order, hinge ok, secures well.

One demantoid garnet chipped.

One or two claws are worn and need re-tipping.

Please note that the pearls have not been tested to confirm whether natural or cultured.

Suggested age: first half 20th century.

Note: the same design of brooch sold at Lawrences Auctioneers of Crewkerne in Jan 2022 for £1200.

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
