LOT 590

A Middle Eastern gold, ruby, diamond and varicoloured enamelled ring, probably Indian, designed as a flowerhead, mounted with a rose cut ruby within a surround of six diamonds between ruby two stone shoulders, the shank with foliate enamelled decoration, unmarked, weight 10.2g, ring size approx P.

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

Some losses to the enamel noticeable at the back of the shank and to the shoulders.

Diamonds and rubies are fairly included stones, some inclusions are surface reaching.

One diamond is badly chipped, another looks to have been reglued into position.

Fairly obvious join at the back of the shank, we do not think this is evidence of resizing but simply how the piece was constructed.
