A pair of gold and turquoise stickpins, circa 1840, connected by a chain, each with three pendant drops, unmarked, weight 5.3g, width of each finial 1.5cm, an 18ct gold ring, mounted with four half-pearls, Birmingham 1901, weight 2.4g (principal half-pearl lacking), and a small group of other jewellery, including seven pairs of cufflinks.

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

Turquoise stickpin - repair to one central drop

18ct gold/pearl ring - resized in the past, lacking central pearl.

Silver, blue gem and enamelled cufflinks - replacement blue gems, heavily worn enamel

Lapis cufflinks - one or two chips to the lapis

All other cufflinks/studs - in fairly good condition, some general scuffing, scratching.

Heart brooch - lacking a number of imitation pearls, some loose

Angular paste brooch - lacking a couple of pastes, some loose

Other costume pieces, in fair condition, some nibbles/scuffing and wear overall.

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
