A George III British military sea service flintlock pistol with round barrel, barrel length 30.5cm, and line-engraved lock, marked with crowned 'GR' cypher and 'Tower', full-stocked in walnut with brass furniture and steel belt slide, the grip with various government marks, including date '1805', the pull-out wood ramrod with brass terminal (flint clamp detached at screw).

Condition Report

4026. Top of flint clamp detached as screw has sheared off, screw is present and was glued at one point. Typical overall bruising of woodwork. Action nice and tight, and half and full cocks. Belt slide a little loose at screw point. Possibly older restoration or cleaning. A nice looking piece.
