Condition Report

2910. The overall pile is very good, no noticeable wear. There are a few areas of light brown staining to the field, but otherwise no signs of repair or damage. One end has been fitted with a series of brass hanging rings and there has been some slight pulling to the fringes resulting in some loss to the pile, particularly central and one corner. Some slight fraying to the other fringe end.
