A single row necklace of branch coral alternating with imitation pearls, length 37cm, a coral bead child's bracelet, a gold and opal single stone stickpin, unmarked, weight 0.8g, a Mexican sterling silver, turquoise, goldstone and varicoloured gem set buckle, weight 63.3g, and a group of other jewellery, including a variety of bead necklaces, a costume brooch, designed as an artist's palette, with a matching pair of earclips, a Yard-O-Led silver cased propelling pencil, London 1947, a Chinese seed pearl ring, a Victoria Young Head half-crown 1878 in a silver pendant mount, with a silver neckchain, three pairs of gem set earrings and a cultured pearl tie stud.

Estimate: £50 - £70

Condition Report

Coral bracelet - needs re-stringing, some natural flaws to beads

Imitation pearl/coral necklace - some wear to imitation pearls, needs re-stringing

Possible amber spherical bead necklace (untested) - in two sections, crazing

Blue bead necklace - lacking clasp

Other necklaces - in fair condition, some wear and signs of use

Imitation pearl ring - some imitation pearls lacking

Green enamelled ring - some losses to enamel

Articulated fish charm - damaged

Section of gilt bracelet, lacking the rest

All other pieces in fair condition, some typical signs of use, scuffing, wear, tarnishing etc.

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
