A Chinese hardstone pendant, late Qing dynasty, carved in the form of a bearded elder holding a child, height 4.9cm, a jade bracelet with Asian character motifs to the links (one jade lacking), and a single row necklace of pale green stone beads.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Jade bracelet - clasp lacking, metal discoloured in places, a few internal flaws to jades, one jade lacking, a few solder repairs evident.

Bead necklace - loose string, needs re-stringing, white beads were previously gilt decorated but now largely lost.

Pendant carving - unevenness of colour, otherwise in fairly good condition.
