Condition Report

1330 - The condition is generally good, and very much how it looks in the online images. The silvered dial is worn. The case is generally ok. It has the typical minor nicks, wear and scratches. It also has a high polish which leaved the wood a little dark and shiny/glossy. Glass mercury tube is intact but some separation to the mercury. The ivory urn finial had to be removed due to the current restrictions.
