## LOT 1210

A Rolex Oyster Perpetual 100m= 300ft Submariner stainless steel gentleman's bracelet wristwatch, probably Ref. 5508, with signed and jewelled 1530 caliber automatic movement, the signed black dial with luminous hour markers, the case with rotating black bezel, Rolex crown to winding button, the tapered bracelet numbered '93150' with signed foldover clasp, detailed 'Steelinox VD', case width 3.8cm (replacement case back and indistinct detail between the lugs).

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

## Condition Report

1210 - Overall the watch is in worn condition. The movement winds and adjusts smoothly and it is currently running, however please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Winding crown screws down tightly. The case has wear and surface scratches. The bezel is particularly worn. Bracelet generally ok and clasp in working order. Replaced case back. As you can see from images 7-9 in our online photographs, the detail between the lugs is indecipherable. The glass/crystal is badly scratched. The dial has all-over craquelure and some speckling but lettering and detail is generally ok. Clasp stamped with 'VD' date code for 1979.
