LOT 1275

A late 19th century French brass cased carriage clock by Maurice & Co, with eight day movement striking and repeating on a gong, the backplate stamped 'E.M & Co' maker's mark, the enamelled chapter ring with black Roman hour numerals within a silvered surround, the glazed case with swing handle, on a stepped base and bracket feet, height 16.8cm with key.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

1275 - The clock going train does not wind or run. The strike mechanism winds and works, repeat also working. Case with typical wear and surface scratches. Back door is missing a pin to top so is loose at present and three corners of the glass door panel are chipped. Both glass side panels are chipped to edges/corners. Silvered dial with slight discolouration and wear. Enamel chapter ring ok with some minor marks.

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
