An Omega 18ct gold rectangular cased gentleman's wristwatch, circa 1939, the signed and jewelled movement numbered '9046901', with dust cover, the signed silvered rectangular dial with black Arabic hour numerals and subsidiary seconds, the signed case back interior detailed '18K 0,750' and numbered '964318', case width 2.1cm, case length including lugs 3.5cm, on a black leather strap.

1198 - The watch winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running, however please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Case with typical surface scratches and wear. Small dent to edge of hinged case back. Hinge to back is good and snaps closed tightly. Good clear marks to case interior. Dial is work with marks around edges and Omega lettering faint. Dust cover fits tightly. Glass is scratched.

Leather strap worn. All condition issues clearly visible in our online images using close-up feature.

Case width 2.1cm. Case length including lugs 3.5cm. Depth including glass 0.7cm.
