A late 20th century French lacquered brass corniche cased carriage alarm clock by L'Epée, the eight day movement striking hours, half hours and repeating on a gong, the backplate with stamped maker's mark, the white enameled dial with black Roman hours, outer Arabic minutes and subsidiary alarm dial and detailed 'Angelus', the glazed case with swing handle and bracket feet, height 17.2cm.
