Dial in good clean condition. Case with typical light surface scratches and wear. Glass with a few scratches and marks.

Seiko 5 - in generally good condition. Winds and adjusts smoothly, day and date roll over as they should and date also adjusts from crown, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. Dial in good order. Case and glass with light surface scratches. Slightly more pronounced scratches to glass at 12 o'clock and between 6 and 7 o'clock. Bracelet is ok if a little dirty. Clasp in good working order.

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
