A Lloyd & Co. pottery commemorative horse racing tankard, circa 1876, printed in black with a list of names of the winning horses and jockeys of The Derby between 1780 and 1876, black printed factory mark to base, height 10cm.

Condition Report

2 vertical haircracks to mug, one opposite the handle running from top rim edge basically to footrim, the other by the handle running from the top rim edge towards the middle of the mug - the shorter only visible to the interior. The longer crack has a small starcrack alongside it.

The mug has overall fine crazing to the glaze and light brown staining.

Two fine starcracks visible to the base underside.

Small spot of wear to lower handle terminal and side edges of handle.
