### LOT 1672

Two Coalport porcelain models of slippers or shoes, early 20th century, the first painted with a lake view against a gilt overlaid cobalt blue and cream ground, the second with a view of boats against a green and cream gilt overlaid ground, blue printed and painted marks to bases, both 12cm long.

Estimate: £50 - £80

### Condition Report

Blue shoe - overall fine crazing to the glaze, some minor staining to underside flat sections where would sit on tabletop. Minute spot of wear to gilt rim on back of heel.

Green shoe - overall fine crazing to the glaze, similar staining to underside flat sections but to lesser degree.

Two minuscule scratches to green ground only noticeable on closer inspection, some minor wear to gilt edge around base.
