Condition Report

Some minor professional restoration to exterior edge of footrim, only noticeable on close inspection due to a slight colour difference, plus there is some associated discolouration to the underside.

One of the handles has a tiny glaze loss nick to its side edge, slightly bigger than pinhead size.

Otherwise in good condition overall.
