An English porcelain two-handled vase and cover, probably H. & R. Daniel, circa 1830, the baluster body painted with birds, flowers and insects, the handles and feet of scrolling foliate design, glazed in pale green with gilt highlights, the pierced domed cover with acanthus leaf finial, unmarked, height 36cm (cover repaired).

Estimate: £40 - £60

Condition Report

The vase itself is primarily in good condition overall with extensive typical fine crazing to the glaze and some very minor brown staining. There is a faint approx 2cm long vertical hairline to the top rim edge.

The cover is extensively broken with amateur visible glue and rivet repairs. It is fundamentally all present apart from a 2.5cm long chip to the underside rim edge.
