A small group of Penkridge Ceramics realistic pottery fruit, comprising a pineapple, height 28cm, two conjoined bananas, a pear and five apples, some impressed marks and applied paper labels (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Pineapple - we were informed by the vendor of this lot they purchased the pineapple directly from the potter as a seconds, there are a lot of loose sections rattling around inside it, one leaf is missing and another is missing its tip. At least three of the other leaves have small chips to their tips. The exterior raised skin of the pineapple has some wear to the high points.

Bananas - visible glued repair through the conjoined stalks.

Two of the apples have snapped wooden stalks and one of these has a glaze blemish to the body (probably another seconds).

Otherwise the fruits are in good condition.
