A small group of Richardson's Vermicular pattern glass, design first registered 1854, comprising a pair of decanters and stoppers, height 26cm, a pair of jugs, height 17.5cm, five champagne saucers, a pair of custard cups and a sherry glass. Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Condition Report

One of the decanters has a tiny bruise to the top rim edge, hardly noticeable, otherwise each piece is in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.

The design is acid etched.
