### LOT 1963

A Moser style cabochon glass cranberry flashed and gilt decorated circular powder box and cover, circa 1900, diameter 13cm, a similar green flashed circular bowl, diameter 23cm, and a small group of other flashed, cut and mostly gilt decorated glass, including a set of eleven bowls with floral wreath decoration, diameter 14cm, a green flashed vase, height 16cm, and a decanter and stopper, height 25.5cm (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

Estimate: £120 - £180

### Condition Report

Conical shaped jar and cover - small flat chip to outer edge of cover's flange which sits inside base when cover in position.

Green cabochon bowl - gilding quite worn overall, tiny nick to inner top rim edge.

Set 11 bowls - 5 have chipping/nicks to the top rim edge. There is a considerable variation to the degree of wear to the gilding and enamels amongst the set of 11. I would say only a couple display very little wear.

Otherwise the items in the lot are in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.
