Three Theresienthal enamelled wine glasses, circa 1907, each with a green and yellow foliate garland beneath a gilt band, height 17cm, a taller Theresienthal glass, enamelled with fruiting vine, height 20.5cm, and eight other similar wine glasses. Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Set of three - each in good condition with no damage but there is wear to the gilding, particularly on the rims.

Pale green glass with gilt edged rim and petal collar to stem - tiny nick to rim of bowl.

Olive green glass gilt with fruiting vine - small chip to exterior edge of foot.

Apricot tint rummer enamelled with prunus - tiny chip to exterior top rim edge.

Remaining items in lot in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.
