A large Doulton Lambeth stoneware vase, dated 1883, decorated by Florence Barlow, monogrammed, with opposing birds on branches against a textured ground, flanked by stylized foliate panels within beaded borders, incised and impressed marks to base, height 47cm (faults and repairs).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

Foot rim - approx. 7.5cm in length section repaired with glue, with signs of old restoration/overpainting to a small section.

A third of the way around from this are two large chips to the foot rim, one looks fresher than the other. Otherwise, only minor chipping to four or five beads within the decoration on the main body, and one to the neck.
