An assorted group of craquelure ice glass, French or Bohemian, circa 1850 and later, including a number of dessert wares in the form of thirteen tazzas or comports, a centrepiece with central trumpet, leaf and shell shaped dishes and two baskets, some pieces with gilt details (minor faults). Provenance: from the collection of John and Poppy Stallebrass.

### Condition Report

The tallest centrepiece with central trumpet has a metal collar repair to the trumpet.

There is a dish with a removable cream and sugar which is missing a central section.

Otherwise items in the lot are generally in good condition overall with no significant damage or repairs.

There are varying degrees of wear to the gilding throughout the items in the lot.
