LOT 1853

A Chribska Czechoslovakian glass vase, designed by Josef Hospodka, probably 1970s, of blue and pink colouring, unmarked, height 26cm, together with a Murano glass bird with gold speckled brown colouring, original applied paper label to base, length 25cm, and a glass vase of bulbous shape with a grey granite like surface and horizontal white detail (fault).

Estimate: £60 - £80

Condition Report

Hospodka vase - there are a few teeny tiny nicks or dings to the body, only visible on very close inspection. There is a tiny flat chip and a minor nick to the outside edge of the foot, again only noticeable on very close inspection.

Bird - in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.

Grey vase - there is an approx 12cm long curved flaw to the base underside, appearing almost like a crease or open crack in the body of the glass, I would suggest it is a manufacturing flaw. Otherwise this vase has some scuffs and marks visible to the white lines on the widest part of the body.
