A French porcelain aesthetic taste part dessert service, late 19th/early 20th century, each piece decorated with a different bird in a natural setting backed by a gilt bamboo framed panel, comprising twelve plates, diameter 22.8cm, a low stand and two comports, one plate marked 'J.G. Depose' amidst decoration (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

3 of the plates have filled chips to the (primarily) underside rim edge, otherwise each piece is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

The gilding and enamels remain bright and strong.

Minimal typical light surface scratches commensurate with age and use.
