Condition Report

There is an unsprung chip or bruise approx 1cm long to the outer side edge of the foot. There are also 6 smaller chips/nicks to the outer side edge/underside of the foot.

One of the birds tails has a couple of nicks to its very fine section near the foot.

The breast of one bird has a small rough manufacturing flaw.

The blue staining is a little worn.

Overall there are typical light surface scratches/scuffs commensurate with age and handling, nothing untoward or unexpected.
