LOT 1941

An engraved Jacobite type glass, mid to late 18th century, the drawn trumpet bowl engraved with a rose in bloom on a leafy stem with two buds, opposing an oak leaf, raised on a plain multiple series airtwist stem and conical foot, height 12.3cm (fault). Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

We have put a low estimate on this glass as the foot is a little unusual and may suggest it has been polished or reduced in same way in the past - basically the underside of the foot has a 1cm wide flat band to the exterior circumference, although the edge of the foot has a nice original rounded finish and there is good typical wear to the underside of the foot.
