### LOT 1919

A double series airtwist stem ale glass, circa 1760, the rounded funnel bowl above a plain stem with a pair of corkscrews outside cable, on a conical foot, height 19cm, together with an airtwist stem wine glass, circa 1760, the tulip shaped bowl above a plain stem with a pair of corkscrews, on a conical foot, height 15cm. Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent. Estimate: £100 - £150

### Condition Report

Ale - appears in good condition overall, foot diameter 7.8cm which is a good size but looks a little misshapen when viewed straight on suggesting some possible reduction, although wear is visible to the entire circumference.

Tulip - generally ok, the foot edge is nicely rounded but the foot does look a little small, 6.5cm diameter.
