LOT 1937

A multiple series airtwist stem wine glass, circa 1750, of probable Jacobite significance, the pan-topped bowl engraved to the rim with a band of flowers, including narcissus, clematis and rose, above the plain stem and conical foot, height 17cm. Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Minuscule rough spot or graze to top rim edge of bowl which also has some very minor scratches. The foot diameter is 7.5cm and is a good even regular size.
