Condition Report

The everted neck rim has some incredibly well executed professional restoration to approx two thirds of it, this is not immediately noticeable at all and only recognisable on incredibly close inspection by someone who knows what they are looking it.

Otherwise the vase is in good condition overall with no crazing to the glaze.
