A Gustavsberg Argenta square dish, circa 1930-50, designed by Wilhelm Kage, decorated in silver against a mottled green ground with a rampant lion, the rim with line detail, painted marks to base with numerals 1196, 21.5cm square, together with an Argenta rectangular vase, dated 1961, decorated in silver with a warship, inscribed 'WASA 1628', gold printed mark to base with original applied paper labels, height 18cm.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

Square dish - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, there are some long craze lines visible primarily when viewed under a strong light.

Vase - crazing to the glaze, there is a pinhead sized glaze flake to the upper side edge of the rim, only noticeable on closer inspection.
