### Condition Report

Man - two tiny flea bite glaze nicks to outer right side edge of base, missing right little finger.

Woman - very small chip to outer right side edge of base, break to right wrist which has old flaking and discoloured restoration, and subsequently the figure is missing the object which would have been held in this hand.
