A large composite stem wine glass, circa 1750, the bell bowl with solid base, engraved with a band of fruiting vine to the rim, raised on an eight-ply airtwist stem above a three-ringed annulated knop sitting on a beaded flattened knop, above a domed foot, height 22.5cm.

Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

Diameter of foot 9.5cm.

There is an approx 1cm long nibbled chip to the edge of the foot, the foot overall looks a good size in proportion to the glass.

There are some scratches to the bowl.
