An airtwist stem wine glass, circa 1750, the rounded funnel bowl with hammered and vertically ribbed moulding, raised on a multiple series airtwist stem with shoulder knob, on a conical foot, height 17cm.

Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Diameter of foot 8cm, a good size in proportion to glass.

A few horizontal scratches to the bowl interior, otherwise in good condition overall.
