LOT 1918

A double series opaque twist stem cordial glass, circa 1770, the basal fluted bowl raised on a plain stem with a multi-ply spiral band outside a pair of corkscrews, on a domed foot, height 16.5cm, together with a similar example with conical foot, height 16.5cm (minor faults).

Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Domed foot - diameter of foot 7.8cm, the underside edge of the foot has been polished in at least one and possibly two spots. The bowl has a small chip to the top rim edge and considerable overall concentrated heavy scratches to the exterior. Please view the images on our website using the zoom function.

Conical foot - diameter of foot 7cm, large chip to edge of foot and two small nicks, the bowl is a little cloudy and has some scratches, the top of the stem exterior has a small manufacturing rough patch/flaw.
