LOT 1945

A faceted stem wine glass, circa 1785, the ogee bowl engraved and polished with a bee opposing a flowering stem, raised on a diamond faceted stem with central knop, above a conical foot, height 14.5cm, together with two other faceted stem glasses, one with a scalloped foot, height 15.3cm, the other with geometric engraved and polished bowl, height 14cm. Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Estimate: £180 - £220

Condition Report

Ogee bowl engraved - diameter of foot 7.3cm, inconsequential spot of polishing to edge of foot, two minute flea bite nicks to faceting of stem, otherwise ok.

Scalloped foot - diameter of foot 6.5cm, noticeable lack of wear to underside of foot which has a couple of minute nicks to its edge, there are two small nicks to the facet edges of the stem noticeable on close inspection, the bowl rim looks as though it may have some polished areas.

Geometric engraved - diameter of foot 6.7cm, foot shape a little uneven with a couple of minuscule nicks, otherwise ok.
