A Herend Chinese Bouquet pattern raspberry colourway part service, made for Candida Tupini, Roma, 20th century, comprising circular tureen and cover with lemon finial, oval platter, length 47cm, circular platter, diameter 33cm, ten dessert plates diameter 24.5cm, six two-handled cups and nine stands, nineteen dinner plates 25.5cm diameter, ten dessert plates diameter 20.8cm, ten plates diameter 19cm, two-handled double-ended sauceboat with integral stand and leaf shaped single-handled dish, blue printed and impressed marks to bases.

Estimate: £250 - £350

Condition Report

Tureen - cover is missing 4cm long section of inner flange, not visible when in position on tureen base. There are a couple of minuscule nicks to the relief flowers on the tureen base.

Sauceboat - crack to upper terminal of one handle and small gilt thumbprint to rim interior, a manufacturing flaw.

20.8cm plates - one with starcrack.

Otherwise the service is in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

There are some typical minor and light knife cuts primarily to the larger serving items, and some stacking wear. But overall the enamels and gilding remain bright and strong.
