A Doulton Lambeth stoneware jug, dated 1882, decorated by Hannah Barlow, monogrammed, with deer between foliate borders glazed in shades of green, impressed and incised marks to base, height 23.5cm (large chip to rim), together with a similar Doulton Lambeth jug, dated 1880, decorated by Hannah Barlow, monogrammed, with horses, height 23.5cm (faults and losses).

Estimate: £100 - £200

Condition Report

Jug with deer - 2.5cm long by 1cm deep chip out of top rim edge above handle. 2 of the square shaped 'beads' beneath the deer scene have chips. There is a minor pinhead sized burst air bubble glaze nick to the edge of the foot. Otherwise in good condition overall.

Jug with horses - missing handle. There would have been a plated or silver collar to the neck rim which is also missing. Missing one tiny 'bead' from band just beneath spout.
