### LOT 1908

An engraved balustroid wine glass, circa 1730, the bell bowl engraved with a band of fruiting vine to the rim above a solid base, raised on an annulated knop above a true baluster, on a conical foot, height 17cm. Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

### Condition Report

Diameter of foot 7.8cm, although a good size it has possibly had some minor polishing as it is a little uneven in shape on close inspection. There is a minuscule nick to the edge of the foot, hardly noticeable. Some scratches to baluster section of stem. The bowl interior has some horizontal scratches.
