### LOT 1508

A George Jones majolica sardine dish, cover and stand, circa 1875, the box and stand with stiff leaf moulding against a turquoise ground, pink glazed interior, the cover with sardine finial, black painted model No. 1831, length of stand 21.3cm.

Estimate: £120 - £180

### Condition Report

Typical overall fine crazing to the glaze.

The stand has a short faint haircrack to the rim on one of the shorter sides.

The box has a vertical haircrack visible to the interior pink glaze on one longer side, not visible to the exterior.

Some glaze fritting to the ochre rim of the box.

The cover has two faint haircracks to the edge, longest 4cm.

None of these issues are immediately apparent, only really noticeable on closer inspection.
