A Gustavsberg Argenta circular charger, circa 1930-50, designed by Wilhelm Kage, decorated in silver with a female nude on the back of a dragon, against a mottled green ground, painted marks to reverse with numerals 1035, diameter 37.8cm.

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

There are small losses of silver to the tips of the dragon's claws, some of its pointed scales, the figure's hair and the looped tendril by the figure - all of these are only noticeable on closer inspection.
