### LOT 1940

A single series multiple airtwist stem wine glass of possible Jacobite significance, circa 1760, the ogee bowl engraved with a bee beside a flower in bud and bloom, the stem with central knob, on a conical foot, height 15cm. Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Estimate: £120 - £180

### Condition Report

Diameter of foot 6.8cm, there is a minuscule nick to the edge of the foot which is only really noticeable on closer inspection. The foot has wear but not a huge amount, although the foot looks a good size and doesn't appear polished. In good condition otherwise.
