LOT 1913

A pedestal stem sweetmeat or champagne glass, circa 1745, the ogee bowl raised on an eight sided Silesian stem between collars, over a domed foot, height 16.3cm, together with a similar example with cut detail, height 14.3cm (faults to second). Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Ogee bowl sweetmeat - diameter of foot 8.3cm. The foot doesn't show any obvious signs of reduction or polishing, but it does visually look a little small for the proportions of the glass. The bowl has a few minor scratches but is in good order and condition overall.

Faceted bowl - diameter of foot 8.8cm, the foot is badly chipped and displays signs of polishing, the top rim edge has some chips. I would suggest some of the faceting is not original to the glass and is to disguise damage overall.
