### LOT 1907

An engraved composite stem wine glass, circa 1740, the tulip shaped bowl finely engraved and polished with fruiting vine opposing a moth, raised on a plain stem section above a beaded inverted baluster and domed foot, height 16cm. Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Estimate: £220 - £280

### Condition Report

Diameter of foot 7.1cm. No apparent signs of polishing or reduction, but does look a little small in proportion to the glass. There are a few minor scratches to the bowl, nothing significant. The stem has a fine thread like flaw to the exterior - a manufacturing flaw only visible on close inspection. In good condition overall.
