LOT 1838

A graduated set of three Baccarat amberina glass scent bottles and stoppers, early 20th century, each circular body with spiral moulding beneath conforming stoppers, height of tallest 17cm (middle size with glued repair to stopper), together with a similar graduated set of three cranberry flashed and cut scent bottles and stoppers, height of tallest 17.5cm, and three pieces of uranium glass in the form of two scent bottles and stoppers and a jar and cover.

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

Amberina - largest has minor chipping to the end of the stopper. Middle size the stopper has a glued repair between the ball top and the end, there is a small chip to the top of the ball stopper and a couple of flea bite digs to the top rim edge of the bottle. The smallest has a minuscule nick to the inner rim edge of the bottle where the stopper sits, only noticeable on very close inspection.

Cranberry flashed - largest has some loss of gilding to the gilt band above the foot, fairly inconsequential, the middle size has a couple of minuscule nicks to the inner rim where the stopper sits, nothing terrible, the smallest is in good condition overall.

Uranium - largest has some minor chipping to the end of the stopper, the other two pieces are in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.
