A matched pair of glass toddy lifters, 19th century, both with faceted detail and ringed neck, 17.5cm and 17.3cm high, together with two glass stirrup cups and a glass sugar crusher. Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Both toddy lifters have some polishing to the top rim edge.

Both stirrup cups are in good condition overall.

The sugar crusher has a chip to the tip of its base end.
