LOT 1953

A double series opaque twist stem ale glass, circa 1760, the ogee bowl engraved with hops and barley, raised on a plain stem with a pair of heavy spiral threads outside a lace twist, on a conical foot, height 19cm, together with a similar double series opaque twist stem ale glass, circa 1760, with plain rounded funnel bowl, height 18cm. Provenance: both purchased from Brian Watson Antique Glass.

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Engraved glass - diameter of foot 7.2cm, there is a lack of wear to the foot suggesting it has been polished, although it remains a good size and in proportion to the glass. Minute nick to top rim edge of glass.
Other ale glass - diameter of foot 7.5cm, there is some unevenness to the foot suggesting some polishing, otherwise in good condition. Bowl ok.
