LOT 1922

Five single series opaque twist stem wine glasses, circa 1760-70, including a plain stem example with basal flute moulded bowl above a pair of spiral gauze on a conical foot, height 15cm, and an example with basal moulded ogee bowl above a centrally knopped multiple spiral opaque twist, on a conical foot, height 15cm (minor faults). Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Basal flute moulded bowl - diameter of foot 6.7cm, has a good distribution of wear and in good condition otherwise.

Moulded ogee bowl - diameter of bowl 6.7cm, minuscule nick to edge of foot - more easily felt than seen, otherwise ok.

Rounded funnel bowl - diameter of foot 6.9cm, there is a dark coloured sizable inclusion to the bowl, otherwise ok.

Pointed rounded bowl - diameter of foot 7.2cm, large chip to edge of foot which has two dark coloured inclusions to it, otherwise ok.

Shortest glass - diameter of foot 6.5cm, in good condition.
