LOT 1923

A double series opaque twist stem wine glass, circa 1770, the hammered bowl on a plain stem with six-ply threads outside a corkscrew, on a conical foot, height 15cm, together with three other double series opaque twist stem wines, each with knopped stem, height of tallest 17.3cm (two with chipped feet). Provenance: Arthur Henry Green, a private collector from Enfield, died 1953. Thence by descent.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

Hammered bowl - diameter of foot 7cm, there is some minor evidence of polishing to the edge of the foot, otherwise ok.

Triple knopped - diameter of foot 7.3cm, small bruise to very edge of foot and a tiny chip to the underside edge of the foot, otherwise ok.

Double knopped - diameter of foot 6.9cm, visible polishing to foot with remains of larger chip in the area, some very minor nicks to edge of foot otherwise, foot overall displays lack of wear. Bowl ok.

Single knopped - diameter of foot 6.9cm, 2 sizable chips to edge of foot, otherwise ok.
